TEXTBOOKS AND WORKBOOKS

For NASSAU COUNTY Residents in the following school districts: Farmingdale and Hicksville. You should be receiving notification toward the end of August from your local school district regarding the books ordered for your child. When you pick the books up, **please do not write your child's name in or on any of them.** These are not necessarily the books your child will be using. All books will be collected during the first week of school and reissued to students as needed. To streamline the book ordering process, books are ordered by grade and **do not** reflect an individual child's placement in our program. Children should bring in a few books each day. It is not necessary to bring them in all at once. All other **NASSAU COUNTY DISTRICTS** are part of the BOCES system, and the books are sent directly to L.I.S.G.

For SUFFOLK COUNTY Residents Suffolk BOCES will send the books directly to L.I.S.G. You do not need to do anything.

ACTIVITY FEE REMINDER The \$150.00 fee covers both the **Activity Package and the Cultural Arts Programs** for the coming year.
